A. Processing of Personal Data when Visiting our Website

During a purely informational visit to our website, certain personal data are automatically collected, processed and stored. This contains the following information: IP address, server log files, some of the information usually transmitted by the browser, insofar as your browser provides it, the type of web browser, the operating system used, color depth of the screen, device type, language settings the domain name of the Internet service provider you use, the website from which you visit us, the pages you visit on our website, and the date and duration of your visit. The processing is carried out exclusively in pseudonymized form and does not allow any direct conclusions to be drawn about your person. This data is not merged with other data sources. There is no personal evaluation of this information.

The aforementioned data is processed by us for the following purposes:

- Ensuring comfortable use of our website,
- Evaluation of system safety and stability,
- as well as the optimization and further development of our website

The legal basis for this processing is our legitimate interests (Art. 6 paragraph 1 lit. f GDPR), which lie in monitoring and maintaining the performance of the website. Further information on the balance of interests is available upon request (contact: see above).

Furthermore, we process title, name, company, position, e-mail address based on your consent pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a GDPR respectively if applicable. pursuant to § 25 para. 1 TTDSG (Telecommunications Telemedia Data Protection Act) for certain purposes, in particular:

- for the sending of newsletters with regular offers
- personalized invitations to events
- for receiving targeted information and offers from Société Générale and possible partner companies,
- for market research and customer surveys
- for personalized use of the website
- to support processes related to the use of the website and live chats
- for evaluation purposes, to analyze trends, usage and activities in connection with our website
- within the framework of securities trading regulations

B. Recipients of the Personal Data

In managing the Website, Société Générale employees from different departments may have access to and/or process your personal data. In this regard, access is limited to those employees whose activities and tasks require it.

In addition, we will only pass on data if:

- the disclosure is necessary to assert, exercise or defend legal claims and there is no reason to assume that you have an overriding interest in the non-disclosure of your data. The legal basis for this processing is our legitimate interest (Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f GDPR) in the enforcement of rights. Further information on the balance of interests is available upon request (contact: see above).
- there is a legal obligation for the disclosure to which Société Générale is subject. The legal basis for this processing is a legal obligation (Art. 6 para. 1 p. 1 lit. c GDPR).
- you have separately consented to the forwarding of your data to a third party, e.g. a connection to the Google network with YouTube is required to play our videos. You will be informed separately about this, and your express consent will be obtained. D. Your Data Protection Rights

We process all personal data in accordance with the GDPR. As the person concerned, you have the following rights:

- Right of access (Article 15 GDPR)
- Right to rectification (Article 16 GDPR)
- Right to erasure („right to be forgotten“) (Article 17 GDPR)
- Right to restriction of processing (Article 18 GDPR)
- Right to data portability (Article 20 GDPR)
- Right to object under Article 21 GDPR.

Please note that the rights to information and deletion are restricted in accordance with the national regulations of §§ 34, 35 Bundesdatenschutzgesetz (BDSG (German Federal Data Protection Act)), which supplement the GDPR. In addition, there is a right to lodge a complaint with a competent supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR in conjunction with § 19 BDSG).
